

**A pair of George III gilt and patinated bronze mounted white marble Cassolettes, England, c. 1790.**

The reversible lids with a leaf-cast finial and foliage and candle nozzle inside, the ovoid white marble body mounted in a patinated bronze tripod richly ornamented with ormolu ram's heads linked with chains suspended swags and acanthus leaves on the hoof feet, a central supporting stem with ball knob and central ring stretcher, on circular bases with beaded borders.
