EACH WITH REMOVABLE LID OF DOUBLE-GADROONED DOMED FORM WITH FOLIATE FINIAL, THE TAPERING RING-TURNED NECK SWAGGED WITH LAUREL AND ABOVE AN ENTRELAC-AND-ROSETTE COLLAR ON A POUNCED AND PEARLED GROUND, THE TAPERING OVOID BODY WITH UPSPRINGING ACANTHUS CUP ISSUING HUSK-TRAILED SCROLLED ARMS, ON A SPREADING CIRCULAR SOCLE WITH GADROONED MOULDING AND STEPPED SQUARE BASE.
